Vision XXI Harker Heights is a program of the Talent Development Sector of the Harker Heights Chamber of Commerce (HHCOC). Our goal is to partner local leaders and key organizations to produce a shared vision of growing the future of the community. Leadership roles are enhanced when given the opportunity to see how participation as individuals really makes a difference.

MISSION & GOALS:

Vision XXI Harker Heights is designed to enhance community leadership through shared knowledge and skill building. By creating a partnership of local people and organizations to produce a shared vision of the future and making it happen.

Classes will begin Thursday April 4th, 2024, and we will be meeting a full day the FIRST Thursday of each month from April - November with Vision XXI Graduation scheduled for November 7th, 2024.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

- 1) The applicant should have a strong commitment to serve the Harker Heights area beyond the Vision XXI Harker Heights program.
- 2) The applicant must demonstrate leadership skills, strong interpersonal skills, and a tendency to be proactive on issues of concern to the community.
- 3) The applicant must have the ability to make a substantial contribution to the issues and program project and to network with peers.
- 4) A financial and time commitment must be made by the applicant's employer or sponsoring organization for the applicant to participate in Vision XXI Harker Heights.

*All applicants must be nominated by: Vision XXI Alumni, Employer, City Leader, Elected Official, Educator, or Military Chain of Command.

VISION XXI CLASS PROJECT

The class has the freedom to choose their own class project as a group contribution to the community. Orientation Day will include Project time – Please come with ideas.

Committees: This self-lead project will have committees, each with their own nominated Secretary & Committee Chair: Marketing, Fundraising, Design, Logistics. There will be one (1) Treasurer.

Recommended meetings: Every 2 weeks

Criteria for class project:

- The Project must be in Harker Heights
- Must be sustainable
- The class must use local vendors and materials (HH Chamber Partners, Central TX, or State)
- The project will need a deadline of completion
- Project idea must be positive influence for the community

* The Vision class project is an extra activity requiring time outside of the course*

*The Steering Committee will suggest two project options for the class or the class can come up with a project that meets the criteria.

Tour Ft. Cavazos and receive military briefing, experience the daily work of our soldiers, and get an inside view into our military partners operations.

Tour and hear from businesses boosting our quality of life in HH. Provide information on non-profit volunteer Centers.

Medical & Health Care

Tour, and meet with the many healthcare providers in our area. Speak to providers about their services and impact on our community.

Economic/Local Government

Tour City Hall, speak to city leaders and spend the day with local government entities. Learn about future economic growth in Harker Heights. Hear from business leaders about some of their contributions to the area.

Graduation/Leadership Day

Graduation is held at a local venue, CTC Continuing Education Credits will be presented to those eligible, introductions to HHCOC committees and functions, leadership activities.

Participation with the HHCOC & Vision XXI Alumni & Mentor groups beyond the class period is highly encouraged.
